Notes for membership charges - The membership fees for 2009 will be paid on the same basis as the 2008 season. Paying fees up front aids the club and team captains and managers in terms of administration. Additionally with the ground development progressing it is important we cover all playing costs for the teams we run. Because of the current economic climate we have opted to freeze match fees at all levels with the only increase being for senior players on their annual membership. This has moved up by £5 to £30 which is still significantly lower than most other local clubs. A senior cricketer playing all league games will pay approximately £140 for their cricket. Social Members - as before each paid up playing member at Junior and Senior level can nominate 4 social members to join the club.

All membership fees should be paid before 30th May - payments after will carry a £5.00 surcharge.

*Students - those in full-time education including University & A level colleges. **Winter Nets for seniors can be paid on a one off basis at £3.00 per session. Junior winter nets can be paid at £2.00 per session.

FAMILY CONCESSIONS: For families with more than one sibling playing cricket, the following membership scale applies - One / Two Children (£25 each), Three Children (£70), Four Children (£85) & Five Children (£95).
